For that reason we implemented a number of advocacy activities before the authorities for development and implementation of sustainable and effective social policies to ensure the improvement of the quality of life of vulnerable people. At the same time, through our member organizations, we provided social, health and educational care and services related to the different needs of the people whom we care for.

But mostly, the Caritas employees have provided in their daily work the Love of Christ from which the vulnerable people most need - isolated in their pain, often living alone, without warmth, understanding and human affection.

*Led by the main Christian virtues - faith and charity, and from the knowledge that "faith without acts is like a tree without fruit" the employees of Caritas will continue in their daily activities to provide the God's love for those in need, because **Caritas is Compassionate Love and Dedication to Neighbor.***

The year in numbers

The main directions on which Caritas Bulgaria concentrates its activities are: providing social, *health and educational care and services; response to emergency situations; advocacy activities*. The care and services are comprehensive and include not only activities for rehabilitation, integration and re-socialization but also activities that prevent people to fall into vulnerable situation. We are realizing our activities and support for people in need through our network of member organizations and their local structures.



- The Mobile teams of Home Care Centers of Caritas provided health and social home care for 334 sick and lonely elderly people from 11 towns and villages - Ruse, Sofia, Belene, Rakovsky, Malko Tarnovo, Zhitnitsa, Stoilovo, Byala Voda, Gramatikovo, Duvanli and Kaloyanovo.
- Day-care centers of Caritas for lonely elderly people in Burgas and Pokrovan provided social and health consulting and activities of interest for 60 lonely elderly people.
- The Center for women in disadvantaged situation "Rojdestvo Hristovo" in Sofia provided social, health and educational care for 58 single mothers.
- The Mobile care of Caritas for homeless people in Burgas and the shelter for homeless people "Dobriyat Samaryanin" in Ruse provided social and health care for 186 homeless people.
- The Migration Service of Caritas in Sofia provided social, health and educational care for 101 refugees, asylum seekers and children in refugee families.
- The Centers "Blagoveshtenie" in Sofia, "Milosardie" in Ruse and "Caritas" in Yambol provided specialized care and activities of interest for 141 children and youth with disabilities.
- The Center for Complementary Study "St. St. Cyril and Methodius" in Kuklen, the Centre for Community Support "Tom Sawyer" in Ruse and activities under the project "Primer", implemented in Banya, provided social and educational care for 303 children and youth in disadvantaged situation.
- The mobile office of Caritas for people dependent on psychoactive substances in Sofia provided health care and specialized consulting for 300 psychoactive substance-dependent people per month.
- After the final of the Appeal for Support the Victims of Floods in Southern Bulgaria, with the collected humanitarian aid and donations, were supported 250 most needy families in the municipalities of Svilengrad, Liubimetz and Parvomai.

Our causes

Following its mission to provide support for the very poor and needy people, Caritas Bulgaria plans and implements a number of advocacy activities. The main aim is to be developed and put into practice long-term and effective social policies that lead to a sustainable improvement of the quality of life of poor and vulnerable people.

Dignified Life for the Elderly People

During 2012 Caritas Bulgaria continued to vindicate the right of dignified life for the low and income elderly people, suffering from serious illnesses and health problems, unable to take care of themselves and their household, needing long-term care but unable to afford expensive medical treatment.

These sick and lonely elderly people need comprehensive health and social care at home that will not only help them to feel peacefully in their own home, but will prevent their unnecessary hospitalization and / or institutionalization. It is of vital importance the state ensures access, long-term sustainability and funding of such home care and services. The pilot practices that exist within the frames of the external financing or operational programs, can not provide to these people the necessary security. For that reason, during the last year Caritas Bulgaria actively has stood on the position for development and implementation of accessible, qualitative and sustainable comprehensive care at home for elderly and sick people and people with disabilities.

- **Let's Share Our Experience about Support Activities for Elderly People** – a national forum organized by Caritas Bulgaria and supported by the Catholic Church in Bulgaria. The meeting was held on 25 October 2012 in Pleven and brought together representatives of the Catholic community who daily care for the sick and lonely elderly people. They all shared their experience and suggested ways for improving the situation of the old people who are socially isolated and suffer in a world where they are counted only as statistical numbers. At the end, all participants looked for ways by which they could join their efforts for more efficient tackling with the problems of the elderly people.



- **Innovative Approaches to Demographic Ageing – Opportunities for Social and Economic Development** – an international conference dedicated to the quality of life of elderly people. The event was held on 29-30 October in Poland, there were representatives of ten European Union member countries, including in Bulgaria. At this meeting Caritas Bulgaria presented its expert opinion on the problems of elderly people living in Bulgaria and offered recommendations related to long-term care, sustainable social services, social activities and employment of elderly.
- **National Strategy for Long-Term Care** – Caritas Bulgaria participated in the Interagency Working Group on the National Strategy for Long-Term Care. At that moment is discussed only the proposal prepared by the Ministry of Labour and Social Policy. In this connection we presented our comments and suggestions which were included in the revised draft of the Strategy.



Reducing Child Poverty

Statistics show that almost half of the children in Bulgaria live at risk of poverty and social exclusion. To overcome some of the negative consequences of this trend, last year Caritas Bulgaria advocated for accessible and quality education, starting from the position that education is an important and necessary step to stop the process of falling in disadvantaged. Timely prevention of falling in disadvantaged at an early age is an important tool to strengthen efforts to combat poverty and social exclusion in general.



- **Tackling Child Poverty – Good Practices, Shaping Policy** – a seminar organized by Caritas Europe, which took place on 19 June at the European Economic and Social Committee in Brussels. At the seminar Caritas Bulgaria presented its best practices in support of children living in poverty.



- **Draft Law on pre-school and school education** – representatives of Caritas Bulgaria took part in the discussion of the Draft-Law prepared by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Science and submitted proposals for its improvement. Starting from the position that education is a fundamental human right and an important factor in the formation of knowledge and life skills of children and young people, and has an essential role in their further implementation in society, Caritas Bulgaria defended two basic components: introduction into the curriculum of the so-called Global Education (an important group of knowledge and skills directly related to today's global world) and providing access to free education for asylum seekers and people received protection in the Republic of Bulgaria under the Asylum and Refugees Law.

- **Confronted with Poverty – Well-Being for Children in Europe** - an international conference dedicated to child poverty in Europe. It was organized by Caritas France and Caritas Europe and took place in Paris, in the days from 19 to 21 of November. For this conference, Caritas Bulgaria has sent a delegation consisting of experts from the Ministry of Labour and Social Policy, the State Agency for Child Protection and the network of Caritas Bulgaria. Topics on which our representatives expressed their position were: "Child trafficking", "Justice for Children", "Children and Migration" and "Solidarity between Generations".



Comprehensive Care for Homeless People

The number of homeless people grows up. Moreover, not just in the big cities but also in the smaller ones. At the same time, there are no permanent and adequate care of them also there are no policies to prevent the risk of falling into homelessness. Therefore, in the past year Caritas Bulgaria advocated the introduction of regulated, sustainable and accessible care for the homeless as well as for adequate steps for their social integration.



- Caritas Burgas has started a pilot service **Mobile Care for Homeless**. The main objective of the project is to reintegrate homeless people in the community and to support them to start a new worthy life. The team's work is focused on building of strong confidence with homeless people, getting familiar in depth with their problems and creating conditions for individual work with them. Besides food, clothing and essential medicines, the mobile team offers free social counselling, assistance for issuance of documents, for temporary placement in a shelter, contact with social and health institutions, as well as free testing for sexually transmitted infections and tuberculosis. Considering the proven effectiveness of the Mobile Care for Homeless, we must look for options for its permanent validation, as well as generally to seek sustainable measures to support the homeless in the city of Burgas.
- At the beginning of the year, local authorities in Ruse addressed to Caritas Ruse for assistance in helping homeless people in the city through the creation of a Crisis Center for Homeless People. This center assisted homeless within two months. For greater sustainability of aid to the homeless and for good partnership, with the joint efforts of the municipality and the Caritas Ruse, at the end of the year was opened a **shelter for homeless people "Dobriyat Samaryanin"**. At the shelter, besides a refuge, homeless people are getting food, clothing, a possibility of maintaining a personal toilet (bathing, washing), as well as consultation and assistance in finding job, issuing of documents, legal and psychological assistance.



- The Ministry of Labour and Social Policy (MLSP) invited Caritas Bulgaria to share its experience in support of homeless people. In this connection, we presented the activities of our network related to homeless people and stated the recorded problems in our daily work. The main among them is the lack of clearly regulated, permanent and sustainable social services for homeless people. At the same time, the existing ones provide partial and incomplete support. At the end of the year, at the invitation of MLSP, we participated in a working group on the occasion of the discussion of **new social service "Social Hostel for Homeless People"**, where we expressed again our position.

Positions and recommendations regarding the three causes: Dignified Life for the Elderly People, Reducing Child Poverty, Comprehensive Care for Homeless People, expressed and advocated in the following documents and international meetings:

- **Shadow Report for the implementation of the strategy “Europe 2020”: “Missing the Train for Inclusive Growth”** - Caritas Bulgaria follows with interest the fulfillment of the government’s commitments to reduce poverty and social exclusion related to the strategy “Europe 2020”. After an extensive research among the poor and vulnerable groups in society, we prepare an annual report examining the situation of poverty and social exclusion in Bulgaria. Our report from last year was related to trends, current policy and challenges facing the implementation of the strategy Europe 2020. It provides recommendations to help achievement the objectives of Bulgaria to reduce poverty and unemployment and to improve the education-related parameters. We place emphasis on issues related to child poverty and poverty among the elderly and people with disabilities. The report prepared by Caritas Bulgaria was presented to key Bulgarian institutions. Furthermore, jointly with the reports of more than 16 national organizations from the Caritas network in Europe, our report was included in the summary report, prepared by Caritas Europa and presented to the European Commission.
- **Second Annual Convention of the European Platform against Poverty and Social Exclusion** - The forum was held in Brussels on 5-7 of December. From Bulgaria participated a state delegation consisted of eight people, led by the Deputy Minister of the Ministry of Labor and Social Policy. Part of this delegation was a representative of Caritas Bulgaria. The meeting was focused on the social investment - activities at national and European level and the package of measures of the European Commission in this area. The forum was organized by the European Commission in cooperation with the Cyprus EU Presidency. It was attended by delegations from member states and candidate countries of the EU, representatives of European institutions, regional and local authorities, NGOs and others.
- **National Strategy for Reducing Poverty and Promoting Social Inclusion** – Through its membership in the National Council on Social Inclusion Issues at the Council of Ministers and in the Interagency Working Group at the Ministry of Labour and Social Policy, Caritas Bulgaria advocated for all three of its key causes. We advocated for inserting in the National Strategy of long-term services - health, social and educational, for children, elderly and homeless people.



- **Operational Programme “Development of Human Resources” – 2014 - 2020** – Caritas Bulgaria participates in a working group preparing the proposal for the new program schedule of the Operational Programme. Our activity is focused mainly on the field concerning the reduction of poverty and promotion of social inclusion. We place emphasis on increasing access to care and services that are long-term, sustainable, high-quality and affordable. Moreover, we are standing the position that these care and services must be comprehensive - health and social care, and to be implemented in a home environment. We advocate also for overcoming the problems associated with the education of disadvantaged children, as well as for comprehensive care for homeless people. One of the best achievements in the priority that we support is that there are included as a target groups not only elderly people with health problems but also people with disabilities, children living in poverty, homeless people, and drug addicted people. This gives us hope that there could be included specialized activities in support for these target groups too.



Our campaigns

Help a Sick and Lonely Old Man to Receive Care and Respect at His Home - Home Care of Caritas

A donation campaign of Caritas in support of sick and lonely elderly people with low or inadequate incomes, suffering from serious illnesses and health problems, unable to take care of themselves and their household, needing long-term care but unable to afford expensive medical treatment.

For them, Caritas implements a Home Care program by which provides comprehensive health and social care at a convenient place where the elderly feel most comfortable - their homes. Besides professional care, the Caritas assistants provide to the elderly warmth and understanding that old people most need. Thus Caritas assistants contribute to overcome social exclusion of the elderly.

Caritas Home Care provide the old man with the calm that he can experience this period of his life at his own home and can relies on the care and support of professionals who helped him to improve his health and to lives with dignity. In care and affection. Because we ARE HUMAN BEINGS!

Through the campaign, besides fundraising by which we can continue to help the elderly in need, we also aim to introduce the general public with:

- a serious social problem - the situation of sick and lonely old people living in extremely low-income, often without relatives who to rely on;
- a well-functioning mechanism for managing with this problem, what in fact Caritas Home Care are – professional comprehensive health and social care and good humane bearing directly at the home of the old man.

During the last year our cause was supported by:

- Raiffeisen Bank Bulgaria for third consecutive year enlisted our cause in its charitable campaign “Choose to Help”.
- Sofia Airport gave us an opportunity to put two donation boxes within the Terminal 1 and Terminal 2.
- Donation platform of the Bulgarian Charities Aid Foundation – our cause was included in that platform, which aims to connect donors with social causes. In this regard, our cause was included in the charity running/cycling duathlon - „1000 km Balkan Charity Challenge” – an initiative of enthusiasts from Bulgaria and Romania, aiming to collect donations for 15 charitable causes of both countries.

Appeal for Support the Victims of Floods in Southern Bulgaria



Caritas Bulgaria has coordinated the **Appeal for Support the Victims of Floods in Southern Bulgaria** which was declared by the Bulgarian Catholic Church. There were collected donations amounting to 6 508 BGN. Also we called the member organizations from Caritas Europa to support the Appeal. By total collected humanitarian aid and fund donations the Caritas volunteers and staff from Yambol, together with the children and youth from the center "Caritas", supported 250 of the most affected families from the municipalities of Svilengrad, Liubimetz and Parvomay.

Volunteers Recruitment Campaign for Recovering the District of Pernik after the Earthquake on 22 May 2012

For supporting the victims after the earthquake on 22 May 2012 in the town of Pernik and Pernik region, Caritas Bulgaria, together with its partners from the Information Portal for NGOs in Bulgaria (www.ngobg.info), Bulgarian Center for Nongovernmental Law (BCNL), CVS Bulgaria, Habitat Bulgaria and www.timeheroes.org, launched a **Volunteers Recruitment Campaign for Recovering the District of Pernik**. Volunteers and staff of Caritas from Sofia participated in restoration activities in stricken houses such as clearing and grading of construction materials, strengthening roofs, interior and exterior painting, general and other activities specified by construction professionals.



Our Network - Capacity Building

For the enhancing professional capacity and motivation of the employees and volunteers of Caritas, we are implementing a number of initiatives, including: seminars, workshops, conferences, summer camps for volunteers, annual meetings for volunteers and partner meetings to exchange experiences with other organizations. In this regard, in 2012 were implemented the following initiatives:

- Caritas Bulgaria and CRS organized a seminar on **"Microcredit for Social Development"**, held on 7-8 February in Sofia. There were discussed topics such as: "Microcredit as a Methodology for Programs for Economic and Social Development", "Principles of Microfinance and its Relationship with the Teachings of the Catholic Church".
- On 22 to 24 May in Sofia was held a **workshop to exchange experiences** with colleagues from Caritas Bosnia and Herzegovina, associated with the Common Management Standards of Caritas. We discussed about the achievements made so far and planned follow-up in our joint partnership.
- Every year Caritas Bulgaria organizes a **Summer School for volunteers**. In 2012 the school was held on 18-22 June in Kaloyanovo village (Plovdiv region), 20 volunteers from all over the country took part in it. The program included morning lectures which gave participants the opportunity to reflect and discuss spiritual subjects such as "Human Dignity", "The Patience" and "Charity"; interactive lectures and activities associated with the Christian nature of volunteering, Caritas as an organized form of charity; the volunteer's skills and helping others as means of lifelong learning. Participants were introduced to the campaigns and activities of Caritas at the international and national level, and came up with their own ideas for the implementation of charitable activities - making souvenirs and postcards, preparation of free lunch to help the people in need and others.
- Caritas Bulgaria's volunteers took part in the **International Summer Camp for Volunteers**, held on 5-12 August in Montenegro. There participated also volunteers from Albania, Kosovo, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Slovenia, Macedonia and Italy. This year the leading topic was related to active aging and solidarity between generations, the main focus was the elderly people and their needs. Participants had the opportunity to visit the elderly in their homes, to learn about their lives, to support them. The school program included topics related to reducing discrimination, marginalization and social exclusion, as well as awareness about the nature of Caritas in its all forms.
- After participation in the preparation of the Draft Law on Volunteering in 2012, Caritas Bulgaria continues to advocate for the need of a **Law on Volunteering**. As an organization that works with volunteers, Caritas Bulgaria vindicates the idea that there should be a clear law on volunteering, to regulate the status of the volunteer's rights, duties and responsibilities.



- Caritas Bulgaria, supported by Caritas Italy and CRS, organized an **International Exchange Experience Meeting among Parish Priests**, which was held on 10-11 October in Sofia. The initiative is part of the project “Regional Partnership for Development of Caritas in the Parish Community” and is implemented within the overall strategy of Caritas in Southeast Europe for the development of volunteering in the parish community. The meeting was attended by parish priests from Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Italy, Montenegro, Serbia, Kosovo, Slovenia and the national PSM coordinators. The participants were introduced to the regional partnership for the development of Caritas in the parish community and its achievements and perspectives. They have shared their experience in working with volunteers and the needy, focused on specific needs and problems for the parishes and commented on possible solutions.



- Caritas Bulgaria organized a seminar on **“Financial Standards and Management”** which took place on 8 November in Sofia. It was attended by employees of Caritas engaged in financial management. There were reviewed and discussed strategies for financial sustainability of NGOs, including ways and tools to achieve financial sustainability of key activities and programs, strategic planning and alternative forms of financing.

- Caritas Bulgaria took part in the **Regional Training of the Caritas Emergency Response Teams**, organized by Caritas Turkey and held on 22-25 of October in Istanbul. The meeting attended by the national coordinators from emergency teams of Caritas organizations from Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Greece, Kosovo, Montenegro, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia and Turkey. The training is part of a regional project for capacity building in emergency situations and focuses on the techniques and methodologies for analysis of the disaster situations. There were presented and discussed coordination mechanisms between national organizations, Caritas Europa and Caritas Internationalis.

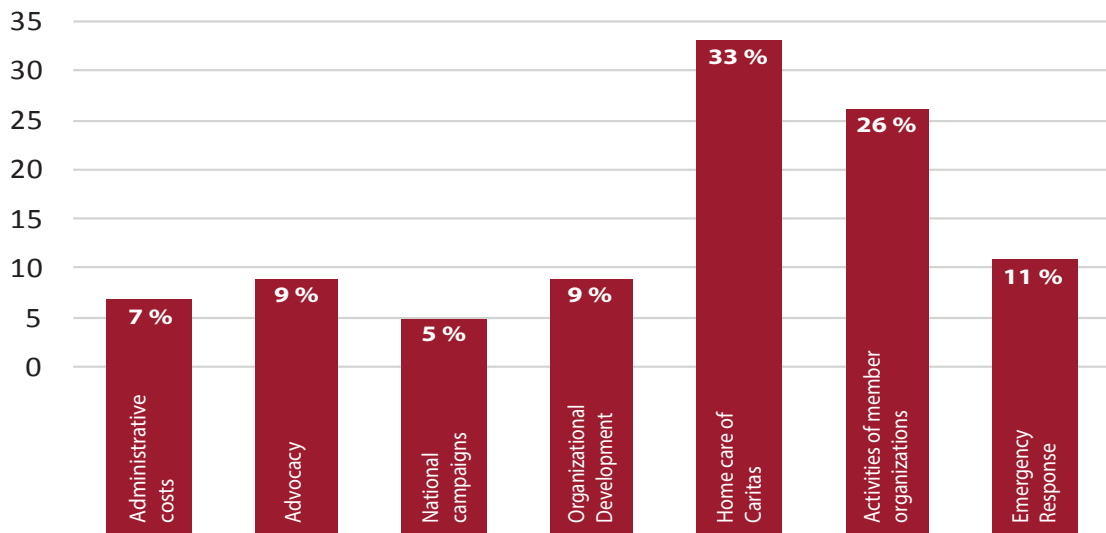


- **To enhance the Capacity of Caritas Emergency Response Teams in the country**, Caritas Bulgaria organized a two-day training that was held in the town of Belene on the 3rd of December. The training is part of a regional project for capacity building of emergency teams responding to disasters, implemented simultaneously from 9 member organizations of Caritas in the region of Southeast Europe. It includes Caritas organizations from Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Greece, Bulgaria, Kosovo, Romania, Serbia, Turkey and Montenegro.

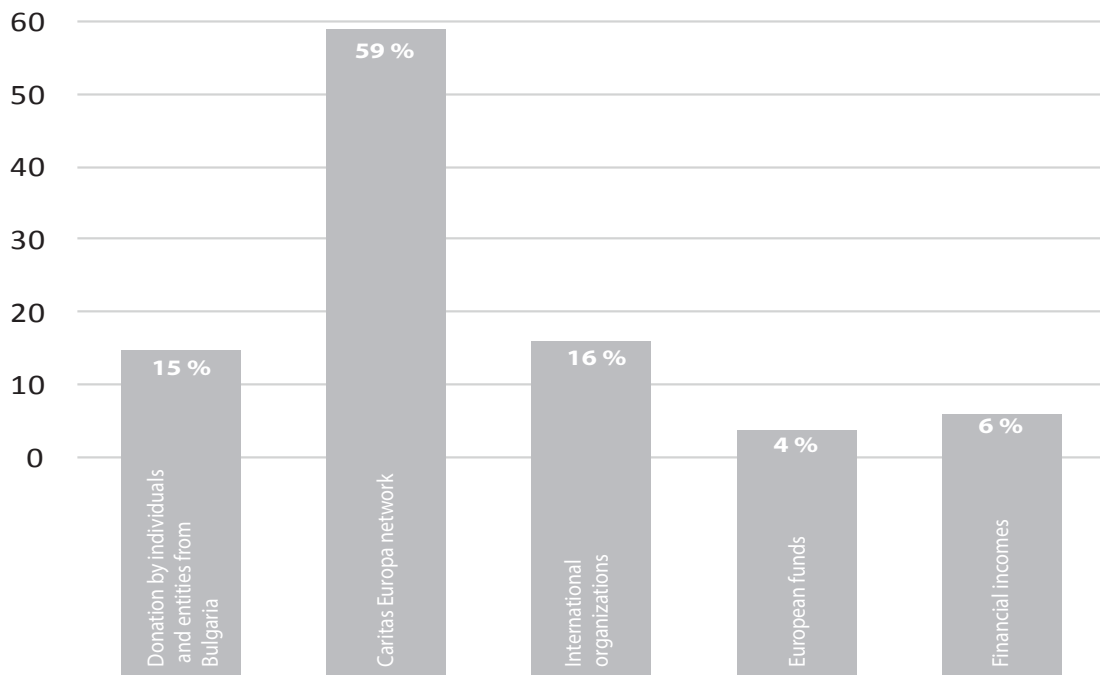


Financial report
